It not will be accepted unique examples and works of insufficient quality.

All works in greatest size of 70 x 50 cm. must have written on the back the following informations: name, surname, address and e-mail of the artist, technique, measures and the date of the creation of the work.

All works will become property of the Town Hall of Francavilla al Mare and Sant Carles de la Ràpita, they will be donated to own International Museums of Graphic Art and they will be included in a permanent exhibition and in its internet sites.
