

## Fifth Annual International Exhibition of Miniatures **little m** 2005-2006

### *History of the exhibition*

Annual International Miniatures Exhibition "little m" originally was organized by gallery "Stiklo karoliukai" in Vilnius since 2001. In 2004 after reorganization of the gallery an honor and duty to organize the Annual International Miniatures Exhibition "little m" was taken by NGO "Actus magnus". It is becoming a tradition to host the exhibition in the exhibition hall of Vilnius city municipality.

### *Rules*

- This exhibition is open to the professional artists of all styles and techniques.
- The size of works must not exceed A4 (210x297mm).
- Graphic works must be presented without mounting or frames.
- Year of creation – 2005.
- Amount of works is limited to 5 pieces per person from which the Organizers reserve the right to select only some (or none) to be shown in the exhibition.
- Each work on the back side must contain label with the following information – the title, artist name and price for artwork.
- The works will be available for purchase during the Exhibition, so, you are kindly to indicate the price for every work.
- Please, write your name, address, email, bank account number; list of your artworks indicating technique, title in English and prices and include your CV;
- The Organizers reserve the right to photograph, copy or print your work for use in any printed media and internet for purposes of the Exhibition.
- "The Miniature of the Year" will be selected by the Jury and the Catalogue will be published to be given to all participating authors. Catalogue is free of charge.

***Deadlines and Delivery of Works***

- Please send your works by December 20, 2005. Due to possible overcrowded post office services we kindly recommend you to send your works as soon as possible.
- Submit your works together with filled entry form to:

- Please, mark "No commercial value!" on your envelope. Any postal or insurance fees required to deliver the works to the exhibition are paid by sender. The Organizers take no responsibility for the damage done to the works during transportation to and from the Exhibition.
- The Exhibition will be held January 7- February 7, 2006. The works will be returned to the authors during period of 5 months after the Exhibition. In order to get your works back, participants must include an empty envelope of appropriate size with return address and international post coupon for the post costs.
